Then have a meeting at Chanhassen and invite the LMPA residents and all agencies needed for the presentation.
- Pete presented a summary on his Weed Management Strategy.
 - Grants are available from the DNR in 2011 for Nuisance, shoreline restoration and inspection
 - We need to plan a Plant/Weed Survey for spring and August. Brittany (DNR) does the surveys for free and reports that we are #2 on the waiting list. Will know in February whether we can get it done in 2011.
 - Lake Restoration feels we can eradicate weeds in a step wise approach. Pete to continue discussions.
 - Pete raised the idea of "Districting" our watershed so that owners might be taxed (say \$50) annually and that money be directed to the LMPA for deployment. He will investigate it and report at the next meeting.
